In this year's placement. the highest CTC package was Rs 31 lakh per annum (LPA), which is Rs 10 lakh more than last year's CTC (Rs 21 LPA). The average and median LPA was Rs 10.8 and Rs 10.4, respectively. Marketing and sales bagged the highest CTC of Rs 31 LPA with IT/ITES and Human Resources grabbing Rs 20 and 12.3 LPA, respectively. The banking, financial and insurance services (BFSI) sector contributed to the most offers (38%) among industries.



As many as 106 recruiters had participated in the placement process with 38 being new firms. Many students have bagged international job roles too. Students were offered a diverse set of roles in areas such as account management, logistics management, enterprise services etc. Collectively, 11 international offers from 7 countries were extended to students, with Rs 31 LPA the highest offered compensation.
